ARABIC 121-3 SECOND-YEAR ARABIC

Arabic 121-3 is the third quarter of the three-quarter sequence of Second-Year Arabic. The course builds on the skills developed in First-Year, and it follows the integrated approach which blends the standard Arabic, Fuṣḥā, and the dialect or colloquial language, āmmiyya, in a way that reflects the authentic practice of native Arabic speakers. Students completing the three quarter sequence will have an overview of Arabic grammar; will have enough vocabulary to speak about themselves, family members, friends, studies, and trips; and will be able to read and comprehend basic authentic texts and write lengthier paragraphs with increased accuracy.
