## HEBREW 121-3 SECOND-YEAR HEBREW

Hebrew 121-3 is the third quarter of Second-Year Hebrew. The purposes of this course are to enlarge the students' vocabulary, to reinforce and expand their knowledge of Hebrew grammar, as well as to deepen their knowledge of Israeli culture. During this quarter, students will expand their knowledge of past tense verb forms, which will allow them to write and converse about their past experiences, their childhood memories, and more.
