FIRST-YEAR ARABIC INTENSIVE SUMMER SESSION

Arabic 111-1 is the first quarter of a three-quarter sequence of First-Year Arabic, which provides a thorough grounding for listening, speaking, reading, and writing Arabic. The course follows the integrated approach which blends the standard Arabic, Fuṣḥā, and the dialect or colloquial language, āmmiyya, in a way that reflects the authentic practice of native Arabic speakers. Students completing the three quarter sequence will have an overview of Arabic grammar; will have enough vocabulary to speak about themselves, family members, friends, studies, and trips; and will be able to read and comprehend basic authentic texts and write lengthier paragraphs with increased accuracy.

Prerequisite: None. Students with prior knowledge of Arabic will need to take the Arabic placement exam before registering.
