

ARABIC 111-2

This is the second quarter of the introductory Arabic language course sequence. The course follows the integrated approach which blends the standard Arabic, Fushā, and the dialect or colloquial language, āmmiyya, in a way that reflects the authentic practice of native Arabic speakers. The course focuses on speaking, listening, reading and writing. After reviewing material from the first quarter, students will learn how to check into a hotel, getting a new passport, eating out and reading a restaurant menu, renting a room and shopping at the vegetable market.
