HEBREW 111-2 FIRST-YEAR HEBREW

Hebrew 111-2 is the second quarter of the threequarter sequence of First-Year Hebrew. This course is based on a communicative-cultural approach weaving together listening, reading, speaking, and writing exercises and practice sessions in each lesson. New vocabulary and new grammatical structures are introduced and practiced orally in anticipation of dealing with written dialogues and short essays. Textbased drills and drills based on audio files expand and reinforce the new material. Students completing three quarters of Hebrew 111 will be able to read and comprehend simple texts on familiar topics, write informal notes and short paragraphs on topics connected to daily life, initiate and sustain conversations on daily-life topics.
